
Introduction

At Kilroy Realty Corporation, we recognize that much of the environmental footprint of our operations lies in our supply chain. This spans all of the services and products we procure to construct and operate our buildings and the services and products that those suppliers in turn procure. To better understand what our supply chain is doing around sustainability, in 2018 we performed an analysis to identify our Tier 1 suppliers, those with whom we have a direct financial relationship, and then further identified Critical Tier 1 suppliers, those for whom a disruption would immediately impact our day-to-day operations. We determined that our Engineering, Janitorial, Security, Landscaping and Parking suppliers fall into this Critical Tier 1 category.

Building on supply chain work done by Host Hotels, we then developed a Supplier Excellence Survey, which we sent to selected Critical Tier 1 suppliers as a beta test. Using our analysis of those results, we sent an improved Supplier Survey to all critical Tier 1 suppliers in 2019 and analyzed the results, summarized in this report. Each critical Tier 1 supplier has been given a personalized report of these results with specific recommendations for improvement, and in this way we hope to influence environmental and social outcomes in our supply chain.


Does your company monitor energy usage?




Does your company monitor renewable energy usage?








What is your company's % of suppliers that publicly support respecting human rights as defined by the United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights?




In the past year has your company had products or services disruptions?
